



Living Donor Specific Rights

- A prospective living donor may stop the evaluation or donation process at any time, and is not required to give a reason.
- The decision not to proceed with donation may be disclosed to the transplant candidate after consent is obtained from the prospective living donor.
- A general nonspecific statement of unsuitability for donation will be given to the transplant candidate to assure living donor confidentiality.
- A prospective living donor has the right to take enough time to reflect on his/her thoughts before consenting to donation.
- All prospective living donors have the right to be free from inducement and/ or coercion regarding the decision to donate.
- The prospective living donor's personal and medical information will be kept private and confidential from the transplant patient.
