WHAT IS REFRACTION?

A refraction is the process of determining your glasses prescription. A refraction is performed for two reasons. First, it determines simply if glasses are required or if your current glasses prescription needs to be changed. Secondly, and most importantly, it determines just how well you see. If your vision cannot be corrected with glasses, it is possible that there could be some other condition going on with your eyes keeping you from having optimal vision.

Although we feel refractions are important, most medical insurance companies will not pay for this service. Medicare does not cover refractions.
